In Chablis, vineyards grow Chardonnay grapes - exclusively. Located in Northeastern France, the most interesting and famous wine-growing part of Burgundy, a region covered by the sea 180 million years ago. This fact gives the soil a unique and unusual composition, characterized by an abundance of seashells - producing a type of limestone vineyard known as Kimmeridge Clay.

Wines of Chablis, known for their fragile mineral character and their crisp acidity, stand out for their quality, which derives from the age-old wine-making tradition of French viticulturists and wine-makers, the cold climate and the mineral wealth of the region's soil. Chablis wines are characterized by their yellow-green colour, fierce acidity and a fruity bouquet of green apples.

The Chardonnay grapes grown in the fertile soil of the Karamitros family's highland vineyards above the shores of Lake Plastiras emphasize and enrich the already refined character of this remarkably adaptable variety.

The history of the Winery Monsieur Nicolas is closely tied to the legend of the French lord Monsieur Nicolas, and to the French culture of wine-making in general, and so it is entirely fitting and natural that the winery has so fully embraced the cultivation of this extraordinary French-Roman variety.

Giorgos Karamitros, with a devoted passion for the high craft of wine-making, artfully employs the technique of Batonnage - along with his own secrets for ageing wine - to produce an exceptional Chardonnay, with a bouquet of green apple, lime and unripened pale-fleshed peach.

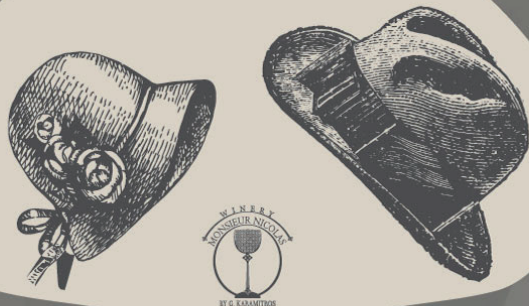
Its 6-month sojourn in French oak barrels strengthens its already robust profile and structure and imparts a discreet aroma of butter and hazelnut - with notes of apple.

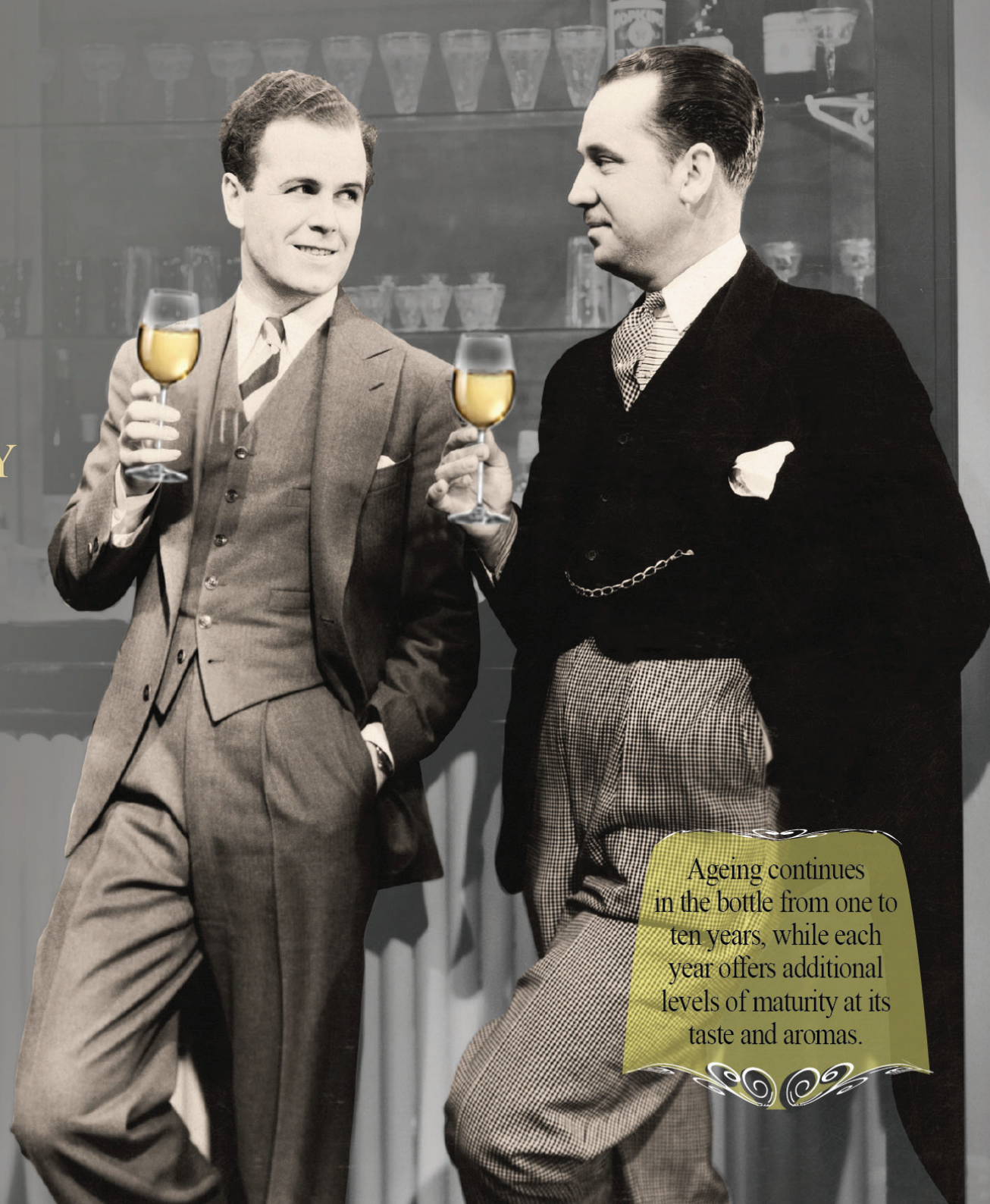

In the year 2000, the younger Giorgos Karamitros founded the Winery as a way of paying tribute to the history, tradition and unique character of the area.



The result is the first and only vertically integrated, modern winery within the Messenicola Protected Designation of Origin (PDO) of the Municipality of Plastiras – with the capability of producing 1 million bottles per year.

From its founding, every year the Winery has won dozens of awards for quality and innovative design in both domestic and international competitions, carrying the wines and reputation of Messenicolas to every corner of the world.
