An exceptional aged Chardonnay from the Winery Monsieur Nicolas. A truly "rich" wine for those who are genuinely noble in their mind and spirit.










Much much later, the creation of Lake Plastiras exerted a beneficial effect on the region's microclimate and produced ideal conditions for the making of truly fine wines.
